

Rachel Sievers Scholarship

Thanks to the generous donation by Chris Fowler to Arkansas Hands & Voices, the Rachel Sievers Scholarship was established in 2018. This scholarship provides educational financial support to students who are deaf or hard of hearing and pursuing higher education.

Arkansas Hands & Voices will announce the amount we will be awarding through the Rachel Sievers Scholarship no later than January 2025.

The scholarship guidelines and preferences are as follows:

- 1. Scholarship will be awarded to a deaf or hard of hearing student.
- 2. Scholarship will be awarded to a graduate of an Arkansas High School.
- Scholarship will be awarded to a student who is pursuing a higher education at a two or four year college or university, a trade school or vocational school, or a graduate student pursuing a secondary degree in a field related to audiology, speech language pathology, or rehabilitation services.
- 4. The scholarship recipient must have at least a 2.75 GPA.
- 5. Preference will be given to individuals who display a need for financial aid.
- 6. Previous recipients cannot reapply.
